Prize money to be collected from Ring Office both days during the show. Prize money not collected by the end of the show will be forfeited.

RING PROGRAMME – RULES

- 1 All protests must be lodged prior to the commencement of Judging any events.
- 2 The decision of the Ring Protest committee is final.
- 3 The Judges decision in final.
- 4 Only Judges, Stewards and Competitors in the class being judged will be allowed in the ring.
- 5 Competitors will not be admitted to the class being judged after commencement of judging.
- 6 No competitor will converse with the Judge whilst being judged except when receiving instructions unless first consulting the steward in charge.
- 7 The Ring Committee reserves the right to alter the program if required.
- 8 The Judge may withhold any prize when there is only one exhibit or where in his or her sole opinion the exhibits are not considered worthy.
- 9 No concessions in entry fees shall be allowed to members in any class in this section where the first prize is \$10 or over. In such cases the entry fee will be stated in the Schedule.
- 10 All horses to be measured by the Official Measurer before competing or hold a current E.F.A Measurement Certificate.
- 11 All horses and ponies to be in their measured classes.
- 12 Registered Saddle Ponies, must not exceed 14 hands. Galloways must exceed 14 hands and must not exceed 15 hands. Hacks must exceed 15 hands.
- 13 Competitor's birth certificate to be available if requested.
- 14 Stallions are not eligible for Hacks events.
- 15 All stallions must be under constant control. (Must have neck collars)
- 16 Jumping events will be held throughout the day and night – times will be decided upon by the Ring Committee.
- 17 All competitors compete entirely at their own risk.
- 18 HEAD PROTECTION – Headwear must be worn appropriate to the section in which the competitor is competing. APPROVED SAFETY HELMETS must be worn for showjumping. All competitors under 18 years must wear an APPROVED SAFETY HELMET
- 19 The Committee accepts no responsibility where a clash of classes occurs.
- 20 Outside assistance to competitors by word, by radio or any other method in Horse Ring Events will NOT be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the showground. Competitors names to be submitted to ASC.
- 21 ***Drug testing may be carried out at this show.***
Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes and disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

PIC NUMBERS – As from 1.9.2012, people with horses on their property need to apply for a Property Identification Code – this is a bio-security measure. PICS are assigned to individual properties and allocated by Livestock Health and Pest Authorities who maintain the register. You may already have a PIC if you pay your rates to LPHA. Forms can be submitted online through www.lhpa.org.au

Every exhibitor bringing horses to the show will be required to list each horse being shown together with the PIC for the property from which it has come, on the waiver form before competing.

HENDRA VIRUS

Waiver form has a disclaimer to be signed by Owner/Rider/Exhibitor and states that the horse is healthy to the best of their knowledge.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

An Unofficial Show Run under EFA and FEI rules.

- Juniors are restricted to riding in one junior class in any class.
- Horses can only compete in 3 consecutive heights.
- Juniors (under 18) may only compete in one six-bar event.

CLASSES CAN BE ALTERED AT THE DISCRETION OF RING COMMITTEE.
