



**TRADE SPACE CONDITIONS**

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES WILL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF SITE OR EVICTION FROM GROUNDS**

1. Stall Holders must report to Trade Space Coordinator upon arrival on grounds.
2. Charges must be paid in full by 12pm on day one of show. The committee reserves the right to reallocate the space of any person/business who fails to comply.
3. All vehicles must be removed from the trade area by 9.30am Friday and Saturday.
4. Set up times are: 9.am-4pm Thursday, 7.00am-9.00am Friday, 7.30am-9.00am Saturday. All displays must be completed by 10am both days of Show. If the space is unoccupied by 10am both days, the committee reserves the right to re let the space.
5. The allotted area is to be used only for the purpose specified on the contract. Selling, hawking or distribution of printed or other matter is not permitted outside the area allotted.
6. No Trader shall excavate, dig or place pegs in his allotted area without obtaining permission from the Committee.
7. No Trader under any circumstances will be allotted a site in the Guild area.
8. All electrical leads must have a current safety tag.
9. Children under 16 years are not permitted to operate a stall.
10. NO dogs or cats are to be obtained in the store holder’s site.
11. The Show Society undertakes to rent the site/building in its present condition.
12. Public address systems, projectors or sound units must not operate at a noise level which inconveniences the showground’s public address system.
13. The immediate area of stands must be maintained in a clean and tidy condition.
14. ONLY Two Trade Passes will be allocated on full payment of site balance. Additional passes may be purchased.
15. The lessee and staff are to conduct themselves in an orderly and respectful manner whilst on the showground.
16. The Show Society will not, under any circumstances, be held responsible for any loss or damage to the stock in trade etc. or any part thereof, of any space holder and/or exhibitor from any cause whatever. **INSURANCE IS THE STALL HOLDERS RESPONSIBILITY. A PUBLIC LIABILITY POLICY FOR \$10 MILLION MUST BE SITED OR A POLICY FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW IS AVAILABLE FROM THE OFFICE AT A COST OF \$30.**
